Digital Photography Part 1 is an introductory course. It is an applied course through which participants learn the basics of digital photographic equipment and digital photography so that they are able to use cameras and smart devices which have cameras to consistently take great photographs.

It is also recommended that you use this course to begin building a portfolio or to grow your portfolio of photos.
